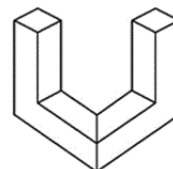

HOW TO USE YOUR NEW STOVE

- Give the instruction manual a quick read.
- You will need to have 3 small kindling fires (approx. 6 pieces of kindling and 2 firelighters) before you have your first fire. Put two firelighters in the middle of the stove at the back then put a stack of 2 horizontally then two the opposite way (see photo) to make a square then two more the opposite way with the firelighters in the middle. Then an additional firelighter on top to warm the flue. Light the firelighters then shut the door (some stoves require the door to be ajar - check instructions) while lighting ensure the air vents are fully open. This will suffice for the kindling fires.
- The first fire will cure the paint which may give off a smell and a bit of smoke. This is nothing to worry about but it is worth leaving a window slightly open to let the smell out.
- When you come to use it properly do the same again but add half a log when you set up the kindling stack. Again leave the vents fully open until the fire is established (by established I mean the biggest log is on fire this usually takes 5-10mins) then you can alter the air inlets. Control the burning as required on the primary air inlet and you are done; you just need to add wood as required.

- We recommend you have the chimney swept at least once a year.
